Oyster reefs improve coastal waters by removing nutrients, reducing erosion and protecting vegetated shorelines, and providing nursery habitat to marine finfish and invertebrates.

Come join experts in shellfish aquaculture and restoration on a tour of working farms and restoration project sites in Charlestown Pond, Rhode Island. A guided tour will be provided by Steven Brown, Coastal Restoration Scientist for The Nature Conservancy.
